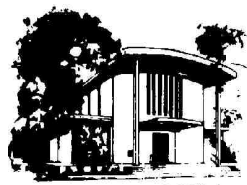

Adelaide Celebration

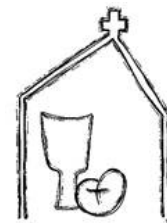
