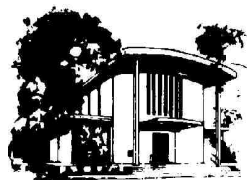

Remembrance Day 2018

Sunday, 11 November 2018 marks the 100th anniversary of the Armistice which ended the First World War (1914-18).

In the four years of the war more than 330,000 Australians had served overseas, and more than 60,000 of them had died.

The social effects of these losses cast a long shadow over the post war decades.

We observe one minute's silence, in memory of those who died or suffered in all wars and armed conflicts.
