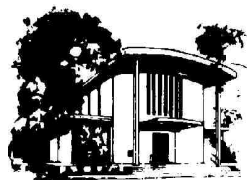

Child Safe Environments Briefing for Volunteers

As you may be aware, all volunteers in our Archdiocese are mandated notifiers under the South Australian Child Protection Legislation. All volunteers who have not participated in a Child Safe Environment training or equivalent course during the last three years, are asked to attend a 90 minute Volunteer Briefing Session facilitated by the Archdiocesan Child Protection Unit.

Please note that these briefings are a compulsory requirement for all the following volunteers (over the age of 18 years):- Commentators, Readers, Extraordinary Ministers, Children's Program Teams, Baptism Teams, Altar Team, Cleaners, Altar Servers and Choir members.

Knights of the Southern Cross and St. Vincent de Paul members will be contacted by their leaders. 2 briefing sessions will be held - one evening and one afternoon so that volunteers can choose the more convenient time.

Afternoon Session:

Tranmere Church

Wednesday 15th May @ 2:00 pm

If you are unable to attend on either of these times, the Child Protection Unit will contact you with further options (which may be further away). Initially we are only taking names for the February session.
