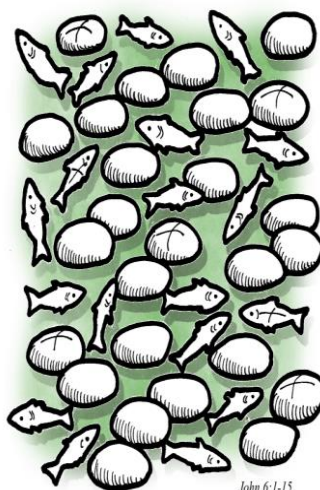

The Kids' Bulletin Jesus Multiplies our Gifts

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time
July 25th, 2021



John 6:1-15

When five thousand people came to hear Jesus,
He turned one boy's bread and fish
into enough for everyone.

How much did He have to start with?
Colour and count the loaves and fishes
with crosses on them to find out!



Jesus saw that a huge crowd of people had come to Him, and He knew that they needed food. However, all they had was a few loaves of bread and a couple fish that a boy had brought along.

Jesus took the five loaves and the two fish and blessed it, and started giving it to the crowd. Soon there was enough to feed five thousand people, plus there were twelve baskets of leftovers!

Jesus still multiplies what we give Him today. At Mass we offer to God some bread and wine and He turns it into the Body and Blood of Jesus!



We have something to offer to Jesus too. If you offer your work, or your talents, or even your whole life to God, He will use your gifts to bring His blessings to the world.
