SPECIAL COLLECTION PROPAGATION OF THE FAITH

Today we take up a special collection for the Propagation of the Faith appeal. The beatification of Pauline Jaricot, founder of the Propagation of the Faith Society, takes place today, May 22 2022. It is 400 years since the establishment of the Congregation for the Evangelisation of Peoples, 200 years since the founding of the Propagation of the Faith Society, and 100 years since the work of Catholic Mission was granted Pontifical status. Pauline Jaricot created a movement that made enormous change in the world. This was done simply, by asking people to give a penny when they gathered in their small groups (a penny in the early 1800s is probably equivalent to the cost of a cappuccino today). Donations were sent to foreign places to serve the poor of her time.
