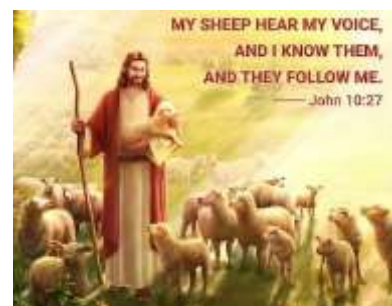

2022 ANNUAL WINTER APPEAL- St Vincent de Paul Society

This winter, **your commitment** to helping those experiencing disadvantage and poverty **is still very much needed and appreciated.**

The Winter Appeal supports the notion that ordinary people are able to make an extraordinary difference in the communities they live. Vinnies Aust. helps 135,000 people each year with food and shelter.

The theme of this year's Winter Appeal "Make it Stop", focuses on the importance of providing safety to families and individuals fleeing domestic violence. During a time where the community has been routinely told to stay home in the interests of public health and safety, a perfect storm has arisen where women and children experiencing domestic and family violence have been put at greater risk of harm by being trapped with their abusers.

Last financial year alone, more than 1000 women and children were accommodated at the Vinnies Women's Crisis Centre with many more in hotel and motel accommodation, being supported by Conference members.

For vulnerable people, getting back to "normal" is not a future to look forward to so your help in providing Vinnies assistance is vital in providing them with hope to escape violence
