Vinnies News: Our local Tranmere Parish Vinnies conference will undergo some changes after the start of the new financial year. The **alterations** are mainly due to firstly the aging of our group, secondly that some of the most active members no longer reside in or near our parish and thirdly that obtaining volunteers from decreasing numbers for increasingly demanding administrative tasks has not been successful.

Acknowledgement of these issues came from within our Tranmere Conference and instigated the change **process**. Fr Roy was consulted and the Pastoral Council kept informed. Once various local options were discussed, the need to work with nearby parishes became obvious. Presidents of adjacent Vinnies groups were approached along with the respective Regional Presidents. Consultation then occurred with Vinnies State Council. Here the alterations were endorsed, being seen as the most practical way to progress.

Essentially, Tranmere Conference will merge with Hectorville Vinnies and the group will be known as **Hectorville/Tranmere Conference**, thus preserving the Tranmere name. Administration will fall under the responsibility of this new group. For Parishioners here, there will still be the usual Poor Box and Winter and Christmas Appeals at our Church and donations will still assist the deserving in our area. Also some of our current members will transfer to the Norwood Conference as boundaries of our new service area alter. Funds remaining in the now closed Tranmere account will be distributed by Vinnies Head Office to both the Norwood and Hectorville Vinnies on the pro-rata basis as decided by our remaining Tranmere members.
