2021 Diocesan Assembly Recommendations

Parishes, communities, schools and agencies in the Archdiocese have received resources from the Archdiocesan Pastoral Service team to assist with the review and feedback of recommendations developed at the 2021 Diocesan Assembly. Communities are asked to hold a gathering to discern which recommendations should take priority in the Archdiocese, and which should have priority in their own context. Resources include a leader's guide, participant workbook, prayer cards, poster, introduction video, participant invitations and announcements. Feedback is requested by August 15. Additional resources are available now for strategic planning for the implementation of recommendations at the local level.
